It is my pleasure to issue the call for scientific papers for the resident papers contest sponsored by the Ohio Orthopaedic Society. This year's 73rd Annual Meeting will be held May 10- 11, 2012 at the Columbus Marriott Northwest, 5605 Blazer Parkway, Dublin, Ohio 43017.

Twelve papers will be selected from both M.D. and D.O. programs from throughout Ohio. Each resident whose paper is chosen for presentation will receive a monetary award of \$250.00. In addition, the top three papers chosen at the meeting will receive an additional \$250.00 each.

Please submit abstracts according to the specifications provided on the enclosed instructions by **January 16, 2012**. The complete **Author Data** and **Official Abstract Page** can be found on-line at 2012 Resident Abstract Submission Forms under the Annual Meeting tab on the Ohio Orthopaedic Society website. www.ohioorthosociety.org

A committee will review the abstracts. They will be reviewed upon the importance of the study (relevance to patient care), creativity, the study design, the execution of the study, the data analysis, the reasonableness of the conclusions and the quality of the presentation.

The best twelve papers will be chosen for oral presentation at the meeting. Each paper will be allotted 7 minutes with open discussion from the floor. Also please note that the Resident Papers will be presented on Friday, May 11th.

You will be receiving your registration packet for the meeting soon. I hope you will make every effort to join with your colleagues and attend this year's meeting.

The Ohio Orthopaedic Society is proud to announce a CALL FOR ABSTRACTS for the Resident's Papers Contest for the 2012 annual meeting.

1. All TWELVE finalists whose papers are selected for presentation will receive a \$250 reimbursement for their expenses and travel, to be used at the finalists' discretion. The top three papers will receive an additional \$250.
2. Papers will be judged on the following criteria:
 - a. Quality of the original work
 - b. Quality of the presentation
 - c. Scientific content and methodology
 - d. Timeliness of the subject
 - e. Overall
3. Residents may submit multiple abstracts, however only one abstract per author will be accepted for the contest.
4. Complete **Author Data and Official Abstract** page can be found on-line at 2012 Resident Abstract Submission Forms under the Annual Meeting tab on the Ohio Orthopaedic Society website.

5. Abstracts must be typed, single-spaced and not smaller than number 12-sized font and contained on a single page provided within the space allotted. Include the title of the paper on the front page of the abstract, but do not include the name of the author(s) on the front of the form. This allows for blind selection of papers by the Program Committee.

7. Abstracts selected for the contest will need to submit signed AAOS Financial Disclosure Statements for every author and co-author by February 28, 2012.

ELIGIBILITY: In order to be eligible, the work must be the work of the principle author who must be a resident in training at the time of submission of the abstract in an approved residency or fellowship within the State of Ohio.
