## New Format to Highlight 2008 Annual Meeting

“Woody Hayes” to appear at Thursday Evening Barbeque

In response to members input the format and content of the 2008 Annual Meeting to be held on May 8th and 9th in Columbus at the Hyatt on Capitol Square will be different than in past years. “This year will be the first year that both DO’s and MD’s are participating and we felt we needed to freshen up our format and allow more members and residents to present papers to showcase the tremendous talent we have in Ohio” according to John Kean, M.D. and Jonathan Feibel, M.D., co-chairs for this year’s meeting.

Changes to the meeting this year will include the following:

- The scientific portion of the meeting will be held on one day with an expanded program. This will allow those physicians with limited time to attend all of the paper presentations and receive CME Credits as well as recertification, etc.
- The residents papers contest has been expanded to showcase more resident presentations. We have doubled the number of resident papers to 12. Each resident will receive \$250 if their paper is selected for presentation and the top 3 papers will receive an additional \$250 each.
- The members papers program has been changed from a

general call for papers. This year a program committee will select a paper to be presented by an Ohio Orthopaedist from each sub-specialty. This will allow each sub-specialty to be represented in the program. However if any member wishes to present a paper every effort will be made to accommodate them if time permits.

- Our popular resident/member “jeopardy contest” will be continued. This lively format tests the scientific knowledge and history of orthopaedics between residents and members. Also a speaker from the Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation has been invited to address our group on the recent changes at the Bureau and plans for the future.

There have been changes in our social program as well.

On Thursday evening, May 8th, a reception and barbeque catered by City Barbeque will be held for all members attending as well as exhibitors. This will allow for greater interaction between doctors and exhibitors in a casual setting.

In addition Roger “Woody Hayes” Thomas will attend and give a roaring pep talk to all participants. Mr. Thomas walks, talks and looks like Woody Hayes, the legendary OSU football coach. This is sure

to be a fun evening and registration is open to all doctors, guests and exhibitors. Be sure to bring your cameras to get a picture of you and “the coach”!

The Thursday golf outing prior to the reception and barbeque will be held at the New Albany Country Club. A buffet lunch will be served beginning at 12 and the first tee time will be at 1pm.



An optional additional golf outing may be scheduled on Saturday morning beginning at 9 am at the Country Club for those members staying over Friday night after the meeting.
